Stressing he wanted to save the timber industry, he said one of the ways to ensure that buyers continue to have confidence in the state's timber industry was to make them believe that the state was serious about preserving and protecting its forests and environment.

At the same time, he reiterated that he would not issue any more timber concessions and would only consider issuing logging licences for new plantations.

“When you start a plantation, of course we have to cut down the trees. Rather than (the timber) being burned, might as well sell it. That I will consider giving licence. But (other than that) enough, I want to preserve our forest.”

As part of the efforts to preserve the state's forest and nature, Adenan said he would increase the number of national parks, nature reserves and animal sanctuaries in the state.
